

#### 2. Organizational chart and processes



The overall functioning of the Institute is supervised by the Board of Management and the Governing Council. Decisions which require a large outlay of funds and are proposed to have significant impact on the operations of the Institute are proposed by committees to the Director. Director analyses the feasibility and usefulness of these initiatives and forwards them to the Board of Management. The Board members meet every week to discuss and decide on pertinent proposals. Some proposals depending on the fund outlay and the magnitude of their consequences are accepted and approved by the Board of Management (for nominal changes and low cash outlay) and some are forwarded for approval from the Governing Council (for significant changes and large cash outlay)

At the beginning of every academic year, committees are constituted with faculty, staff and student members identified as members. Broad outline of the expected activities under each committee are discussed in faculty council meetings.

Each committee assumes charge and plans activities for the year. All activities are submitted to the Director Office where the Academic Calendar is finalized after including all proposed events. Once circulated the Academic Calendar is adhered to in strict compliance unless there are exigencies.

#### **Credit Requirements**

#### a. Credits

A research scholar shall undergo 4 Courses of the total 12 credits in the first module. During the second module he/ she shall undergo three stream-specific Courses of 3 credits each and give a three credit Seminar on General Management topic. In the third module, the candidate shall give a three credit Seminar and write a Literature Review paper (3 credits) related to his/ her research topic for publication purpose. Thus a candidate shall earn 12 credits in the first and second modules and 6 credits in the third module together adding up to 30 credits.

#### b. Details of Courses and Seminar

The stream specific Courses and Seminars shall be approved by the Director on the recommendations of the candidate's Guide(s) and the Research Advisory Committee.

### c. Duration for earning Credit

Modules 1 and 2 shall be completed within one calendar year of admission to the program. Modules 3 shall be completed within 6 months thereafter.

#### d. Guide allocation

The first faculty Research Guide will be allotted after successful completion of the Module 2.

e. **Proposal Presentation:** The research scholar must make the Research Proposal Presentation within 6 months of successful completion of Module 3. This will be reviewed by the Faculty council & Research Advisory Committee.

#### f. Grading System of Credit Courses/Seminar

The minimum of CGPA of 6.0 on a 10 point scale or 60% is required for passing Course/ Seminar. A candidate getting less than 60% shall be given one more opportunity to repeat the Course/ Seminar. If he/ she still does not pass in the Course/ Seminar, he/ she shall be terminated from the Fellow Programme.
